Dear Landholder:

***A new optical repeater site location is being considered for the Fort McMurray West
500-kilovolt (kV) Transmission Project and you may be affected***

In July 2015, we distributed information about optical repeater sites to land interest holders within the vicinity of the planned site locations. A copy of this information has been included for your reference. Ongoing transmission line development and design has led Alberta PowerLine to identify a new location for one of the optical repeater sites along the West Route option.

At this time, the planned Sander Lake optical repeater site in NE 4-80-2-W5 is no longer being considered (see enclosed facility detail map FD-094W-R1) and is being replaced by the planned Muskwa optical repeater site in NE 19-83-W4 (see enclosed facility detail maps FD-109W-R1 and FD-110W-R1).
